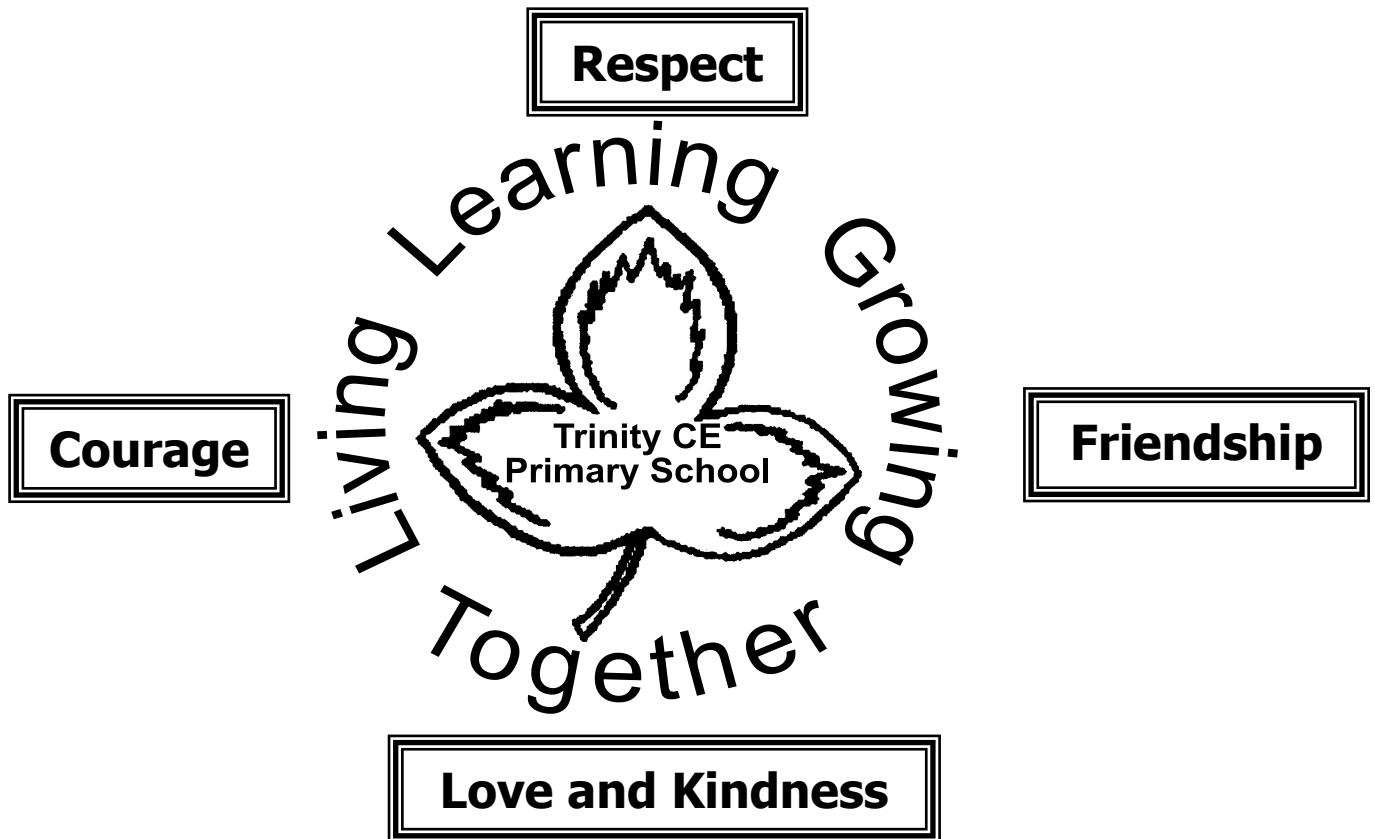


Trinity CE Primary School
